ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS TO THE SCHOOL OF ARCHITECTURE

Admission to the School of Architecture is controlled by the general requirements for admission into Oklahoma State University, and specifically the requirements for admission into the College of Engineering, Architecture, and Technology

Admittance into the Design Studios is open unless demand exceeds available space. In that case, the student's GPA may be a consideration for acceptance into ARCH 1216, 2116, and 2216. Students who have not already received a grade for the studio will be given first priority in enrollment.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS TO PROFESSIONAL SCHOOL

Students in the major of Architecture who meet the criteria for consideration will be selected for admission to the Professional School in the School of Architecture.

Professional School Criteria:

- Obtained a minimum of 55 credit hours applicable toward the degree
- Completion of ARCH 1112, 2003, 1216, 2116, 2216, 2263, 3252, MATH 2144, ENSC 2113, PHYS 1114, ENGL 1113 with a Selection Grade point Average of 2.8.

For detailed explanation of the Professional School admission policy, obtain a copy of the application form from the School of Architecture Office.

The student will be held responsible for degree requirements in effect at the time of matriculation (date of first enrollment), plus any changes that are made, so long as these changes do not result in semester hours being added or do not delay graduation.

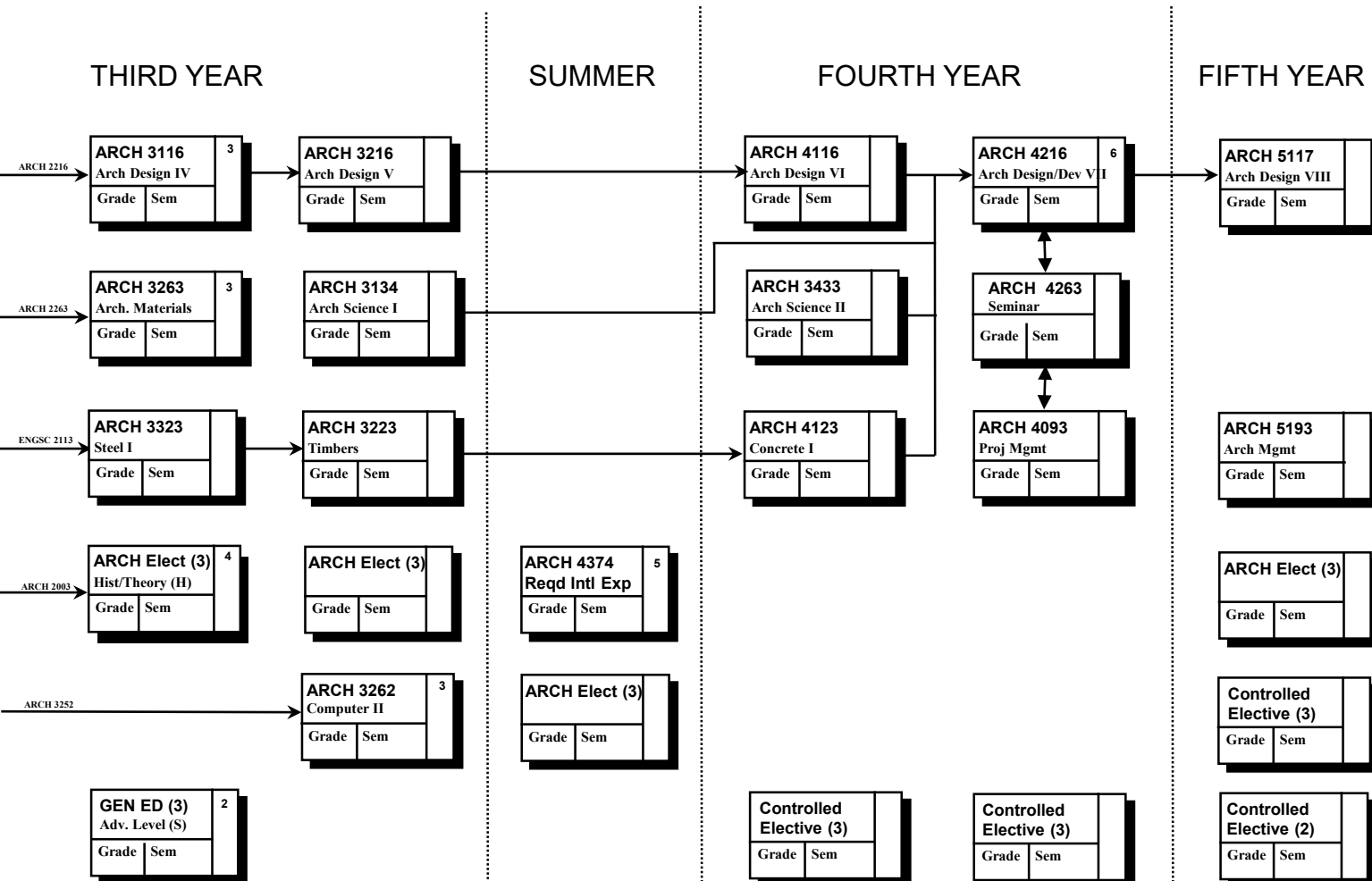
NOTE: The School of Architecture requires a final grade of "C" or better in all ARCH prefix courses, substitutions for ARCH prefix courses, and prerequisites for ARCH prefix courses.

GENERAL EDUCATION
Students are required to take at least 40 credit hours of General Education courses met by required courses and electives. These must include:

(A), 7 hours: MATH 2144, ENSC 2113.

(H), 6 hours: ARCH 2003 and ARCH__3 H/T course.

(S), 3 hours lower division "S" and 3 hours upper division "S": see list of Approved upper "S" courses with focus on Urban Issues.

(I), 3 hours: ARCH 2003.

(D), 3 hours: Diversity component.

(N), 7 hours: PHYS 1114 and one course from

ASTR 1014, 1024;
BIOL 1114; BOT 1404;
CHEM 1314, 1414; DHM 2573;
GEOG 1114, 3023, 3033;
GEOL 1014, 1114; HORT 1013;
NSCI 2114.

ARCHITECTURE ELECTIVES
Students are required to take 9 credit hours of ARCH electives and 3 Hours of ARCH History and Theory, for a total of 9 hours of ARCH H/T.

CONTROLLED ELECTIVES
Students are required to take 11 credit hours of CONTROLLED electives, selected in consultation with the head of the School of Architecture and/or the Academic Advisor.
